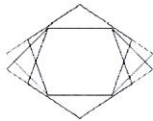
The Protective Services Committee conducted no business.

The next meeting of the Panel will be open to public comment on the draft plan starting at 6 p.m. on February 9, 2021. There will also be a public portal for comments.

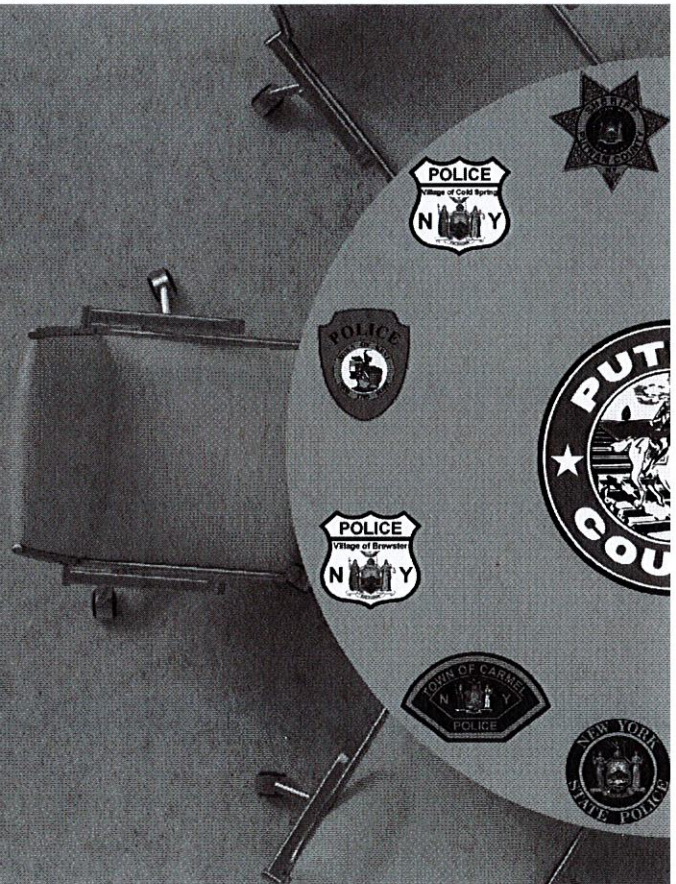
